

**CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP SEWERAGE AUTHORITY  
RESOLUTION 2020-20**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE SEWER RATE SCHEDULE**

**WHEREAS**, The Carneys Point Township Sewerage Authority (Authority) has conducted a five year revenue and expenditure financial review, consisting of two years of historical information, the current year projected results, and two proforma future years; and

**WHEREAS**, the financial review has shown that as a result of normal operating expense inflation and the capital improvements required to maintain and possibly expand the sewer system, the current rate structure is no longer adequate to maintain a balanced budget; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to maintain a balanced budget, the board has determined that on July 1, 2020 there is a need to amend the current Sewer rates to the proposed rates in Attachment I of Resolution 2020-14; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23, the Authority has conducted a rate hearing at after timely advertising said hearing for the meeting today, April 21, 2020 at 5:30 p.m., at the Carneys Point Township Municipal Building located at 303 Harding Highway, Carneys Point Township, Salem County New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, all proposed adjustments to the Authority's existing Sewer Rate Schedule were discussed with the public and are set forth in Attachment I and II to this Resolution; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP SEWERAGE AUTHORITY**, that all necessary contracts with New Jersey American Water be executed by the Office Manager as early as possible in order to facilitate the electronic download of commercial property meter readings into the Authority's billing software.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that if it is not administratively possible to implement the rates in Attachment I and II by July 1, 2020 due to the Coronavirus quarantines, they should be implemented no later than October 1, 2020.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon ending of the State imposed shut off restrictions due to the Coronavirus, the Office Manager will contact New Jersey American Water to begin enforcing section 9.3 (A) of the current rate schedule that allows the Authority to shut off water on accounts that have Sewer bills that are delinquent for at least 30 days.
