Construction of upgrades and improvements for the Lafayette Road Sanitary Sewer Improvements in Carneys Point, Salem County, NJ (Construction Cost: \$1,379,937.25) were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits through the removal of an aging sanitary sewer pump station and construction of new sanitary sewer mains to ensure continued high-quality sanitary sewer service for residents and businesses in Carneys Point Township.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
